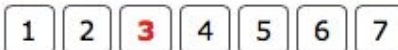

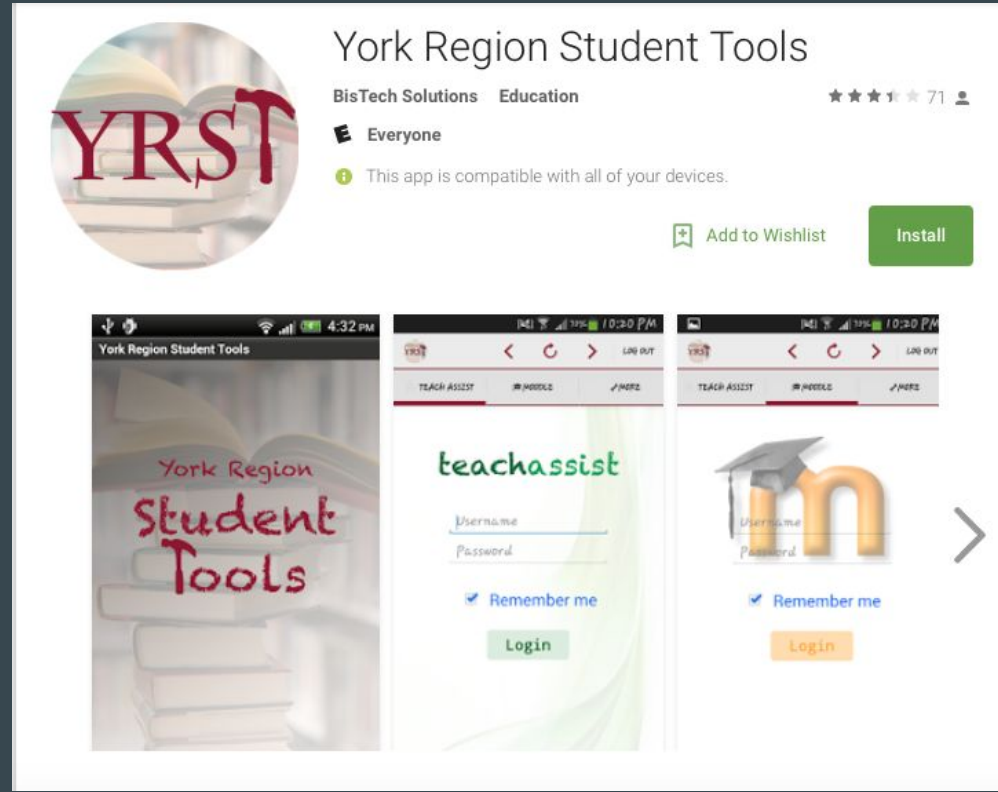
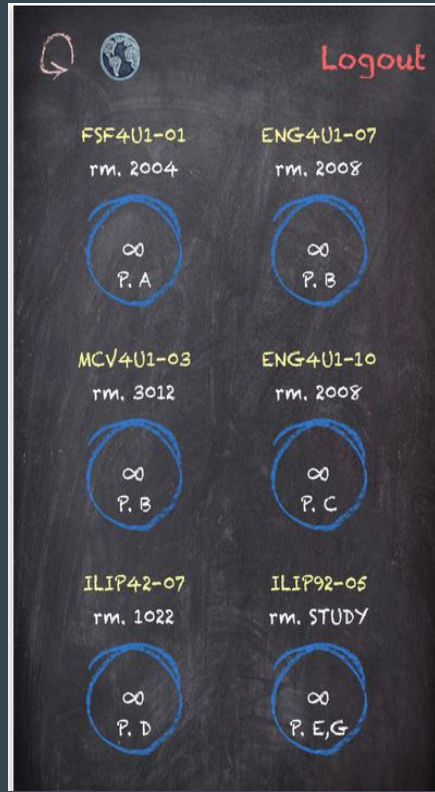
**Important Definition: Technological Determinism** (def): *Social change is initiated by technology, and not necessarily by individuals.*  
Technologies, once invented, take on a 'life of their own;' society adapts to the subsequent changes.

<u>Type of Technology</u>	<u>Advantages of this technology</u>	<u>Negative consequences to society or unintended effects of this technology on society</u>	<u>Has this technology determined human behaviour? (yes or no) Provide one example.</u>	<u>How might this technology change in 10 years from now? (try starting with an "if ..." statement.</u>
Agricultural Irrigation	Food production becomes much more efficient	People can accidentally leave systems on and misuse / overuse water	Where available, it is the industry standard without question. Farming and water use may become less valued because of the decreased amount of labour involved, thus making society take farming for granted more.	If environmentalism strengthens in the developed world, more efficient versions of these will be invented; laws can be made, etc.
Machinery in Factories	They increase the efficiency in the workplace  Decrease cost of production.	Significant job losses, which (paired with globalization) has had devastating effects on towns that relied on these jobs.	Yes, it makes people more dependent on machines. This has been the case in societies where corporate profits and investor-return are highly valued.	- The trend is that machinery would get more advanced as times goes on, which in turn will increase efficiency. On the other hand, it would uneventfully put many workers out of jobs which in turn will be disadvantageous to the economy.
