Student Success

SHSM

- 60 Students were given the opportunity to get their 1st Aid/ CPR Certifications which are Mandatory Certifications for all sectors.
- Cost per student was \$100 each the costs were covered by the school/ board

Principal's Report

- Mr. Bharucha spoke about appropriate conduct and behavior with community partners, especially in the plaza across the street as complaints had been received from vendors there about inappropriate behavior, shoplifting and racist comments. He emphasized how parents as partners need to work with the school to have appropriate messaging about behavior and that some vendors have stopped allowing kids for lunch.
- Mr. Bharucha said Activity Fees have not yet been paid fully. These fees help support the various programs, clubs, sports teams and other student life enrichment opportunities and that parents are highly encouraged to pay the activity fee.
- Mr. Bharucha also spoke about Student Conduct Protocols.
- Mr. Bharucha provided an update about school's recovery from the system outage, and that the school did not miss a beat, did well and coped the old-fashioned way; the Mid-Term Report Cards were ready in spite of this system outage.
- Mr. Bharucha spoke about Winter Break Talent Show Modified Timetable.
- Mr. Bharucha spoke about RGSS's official instagram: @rgssofficial as another community channel. He asked everyone to please follow the account.
- Ms. Gupta update the council about that End of Semester information: PA DAy agenda, Course Selection, report cards date (2nd week of Feb. 2024).
- Ms. Chowdhury added key information about the Exams would be provided to families, including bussing schedules, students rules to be followed during Exam

time; for example students can only stay in cafeteria/gym before and after their exam time.
