## EQAO Math results

(Mark Gatti, Head of Mathematics)

#### **ACADEMIC RESULTS**

- Reviewed background & format of EQAO testing
- Counts 5% towards grade 9 mark not a graduating requirement



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- 92% met provincial standard +3
- School results higher than Board & Provincial
- Results by gender = the same
- Applied Math Results 50% met the Provincial standard
- Results higher than Board & Province
- Steady increase in results over past 5 years
- Gender bias toward female = 67% meeting standard (Males @ 42%) -
- Gender bias results not consistent with Board o or province.
- Will be explored/addressed going forward

#### **ACTION ITEMS**

- Improvement focus on applied program
- Address female bias of results in the applied program
- Overall focus on geometry and metrics
- School wide numeracy focus
- Partnership with Grade 8 feeder schools

# EQAO Literacy Results

Paula Borges (head of English)

Martha Bazos (head of ESL, literacy teacher)

Advised that resources = available for parents to support the EQAO test at home for 2013

- 95% vs Board @ 94%
- Multiple choice & short answer results = good
- Improvement needed in summarizing, inferring & making connections

## **ACTION ITEMS**

- Whole school approach to address areas for improvement (above)
- Also focus on critical thinking & problem solving to be integrated in teaching across all subjects
- Literacy room operates during lunch hours Rm 138
- Using similar/same terminology in testing in other subjects to increase familiarity with testing structure
